

Bethel Park Volunteer Scholarship Fund

The Bethel Park Volunteer Scholarship Fund is available to any individual in the community who has shown a high degree of civic responsibility through their volunteer efforts, and wishes to start, continue or further their higher education. This scholarship is open to students and adults. The volunteer participation must be in service of an organization within the Bethel Park Community.

Application Process: Applications will be made available in January at the Bethel Park High School, or by request through dcable@bethelaprk.net. They will be due March 1, and reviewed during by the board before the deadline of April 30. The selection will be announced in May.

Application Requirements:

- Must volunteer for a combined 200 hours with organizations, facilities or events directly related to Bethel Park.
- Must graduate with a high school QPA of no less than 2.75.
- Applicants are eligible to apply once every calendar year while attending a secondary educational institution while their QPA remains above 3.0.

All candidates must submit a “Bethel Park Scholarship Fund Application Form” along with an optional cover letter, and up to three letters of recommendation.

Awards: One: \$1000.00 will be given out annually.

Award Process: The application form will collect the following information: Hours volunteered, organization(s) aided, QPA, optional essay. The three person board will review the content of all applications, and choose the candidate based on the quantifiable information and optional essay. A consensus vote by the board will be used to select the Candidate(s).
