**Here are just a few grant highlights from the past three years.**

- 2015 \$ 8,300 granted to the Bethel Park Community Center for new lobby furniture.  
\$ 859 granted to the Bethel Park High School DECA Club for new presentation blazers.  
\$ 4,130 granted to the Bethel Park Community Center for new folding tables.  
\$ 2,850 granted to sponsor the Dean Streater Tower Concert Series.  
\$ 350 granted to "Operation Troop Appreciate", a Bethel Park Eagle Scout project.  
\$ 350 granted to Bethel Park Slow Pitch Association for a remote control for the scoreboard.  
\$ 4,000 granted to Bethel Park School District to underwrite the "Rachael's Challenge", a series of presentations on anti bullying.
- 2014 \$ 4,130 granted to the Bethel Park Community Center for 20 tables.  
\$ 1,250 granted to the Bethel Park High School – Blackhawk TV production.  
\$ 5,902 granted to help start the Anna Mae & Samuel Richardson Community Garden.  
\$ 3,000 granted to the Bethel Park Athletic Hall of Fame for new display cases.  
\$ 2,700 granted to sponsor the Dean Streater Tower Concert Series.  
\$ 2,700 granted to the Bethel Park Recreation and Bethel Park Library for the Town Hall Speaker Series.
- 2013 \$15,000 granted to Bethel Park Junior Football for field lighting project.  
\$ 4,000 granted to the Bethel Park Recreation Department for 20 canopy tents.

### **Bethel Park Community Foundation also oversees 4 annual college scholarships and 2 restricted community funds.**
